

How much should you tip on your cruise? Here are the cruise lines' suggested gratuities. As Dwayne explained to May, automatically adding gratuities to passengers' onboard invoice has become standard practice in the cruise industry. And although tipping isn't required on your cruise, it's proper cruising etiquette to do so. When figuring out your cruise budget, don't forget to factor in these suggested tips per passenger, per day.

Carnival Cruise Line: Staterooms: \$13.99 per person each day. Suites: \$15.99 per person each day.

Celebrity Cruises: Standard cabins: \$14.50 per person each day. Concierge Class: \$15 per person each day. Suites: \$18 per person each day.

Disney Cruise Line: Disney recommends the following gratuities on its cruises: 3-night cruise: \$40.50 per person per cruise. 4-night cruise \$54 per person per cruise. 7-night cruise: \$94 per person per cruise.

Holland America: Staterooms: \$14.50 per day per passenger. Suites: \$16 per day per passenger.

Norwegian Cruise Line: Staterooms: \$15 per person per day; The Haven, Concierge, and Suites: \$18 per person per day. (Guests ages three and up)

Oceania Cruises: Staterooms: \$16 per person per day; \$23 per person for guest in suites with butlers.

Princess Cruises: Staterooms: \$14.50 per person per day. Mini-suites and club class: \$15.50 per person per day. Suites: \$16.50 per person per day.

Royal Caribbean: Jr suites and below: \$14.50 per person per day; Grand Suites and above: \$17.50 per person per day.
